## Background

- In the 'bundled rate' era, electric water heaters were competition with gas water heaters
- 'Flat Rate' was based on 'anticipated' usage
- Used as Peak Shaving (utility could switch off for 90 minutes)
- In 1999, the former regulator disallowed Flat Rate Water Heaters
- LDCs generally discontinued the rate



## **Present Situation**

There may be a few LDCs that still have customers on 'Flat Rates' (one example raised at kick-off meeting)

 Team discussion indicated that deemed water heater usage (based on size of element and tank) is added to arrive at the energy billed



## Proposal for Informational Filings: Supplementary Questions

- Ask supplemental question to determine how many LDCs have deemed consumption billing procedures (exclude USL)
- Ask LDCs to disclose how the consumption is estimated
- Ask LDCs to disclose the number of units per type (e.g. element size and gallons) and associated load estimation for load data purposes
- Also ask LDCs to estimate the cost to convert existing customers back to the meter
