BHT Undertaking K9.5: Provide the amount of unsubscribed Vector capacity in 2001, or the study period of the Acres study.

Response:

The Acre's study is dated July 2002. According to Vector, for the months December 2000 and January through March 2001, Vector was being utilized to serve the original long-term contracts of the initial capacity of 700,000 Dth/day. Vector's Highland Compressor station was placed in service in January 2002 bringing Vector's capacity up to its full authorized capacity of 1Bcf/day, noted on p.11 of the Acres report. According to Vector, for the months of June through August 2002, Vector had unsubscribed firm capacity from Joliet to Dawn of 205,200 Dth/day. This capacity was available at all available points including Washington 10, Milford and Belle River Mills.
