Re: EB-2006-0030 - Proposed Amendments to the Distribution System Code

With regard to the Board's request for submissions on the proposed amendments to the Distribution System Code as it relates to Consumer Security Deposits for bulk metered residential condominiums, we would like to provide the following comments:

- 1) Identifying Bulk Metered Residential Condominiums There is difficulty in identifying bulk metered residential condominiums as many are listed under Ontario Limited Numbered Companies or other non-specific titles. The requirement should be for these customers to "self-declare" in order that we may identify them and apply the proposed security deposit procedures.
- 2) Communication to Bulk Metered Condominiums Due to the reason stated above the communication of these proposed security deposit changes to the relevant associations either through direct contact or mass communication mediums should be coordinated by the Ontario Energy Board.
- 3) Standard Self-Declaration Form for Bulk Metered Residential Condominiums A standard Self-declaration form should be developed for use by Bulk Metered Residential Condominiums in order that information is relayed to LDC's in a consistent manner.
