Extension of Filing Timeline Intervenor Cost Submissions

By this letter the Board is granting an extension to the dates specified in Procedural Order No. 11 for filing cost claims by certain intervenors eligible for an award of cost and an extension for subsequent filings in reply to the cost claims filings.

On July 8, 2008, Pollution Probe requested an extension for cost claims filing citing "exceptional circumstances". The exceptional circumstances explained by Pollution Probe include an extremely busy caseload, absence of key staff responsible for cost claims preparation, and complexity of cost claims in the Bruce to Milton proceeding.

Two other intervenors, Mr. Pappas and Mr. Barlow, wrote to the Board July 9, 2008, in support of Pollution Probe's extension request.

On July 14, 2008, Hydro One filed a letter in reply to the Pollution Probe's request. Hydro one did not oppose that an extension be granted to Pollution Probe however requested that the date for filing replies to Cost Submissions change. Hydro One requested that the Board extend the date for its replies to Cost Submissions.

The Board accepts the request of Pollution Probe, Mr. Barlow and Mr. Pappas for the extension and sets the following timeline related to these intervenors for filing cost claims:

- Intervenors shall file their cost submissions in accordance with the Practice
 Direction on Cost Awards with the Board Secretary and with Hydro One
 Networks Inc. no later than Friday July 18, 2008.
- Hydro One Networks Inc. may make submissions regarding the cost claims no later than Friday, August 8, 2008; and
- The intervenors may reply no later than Friday, August 15, 2008.

A decision and order on the Cost Award will be issued in due course.
