Purpose of Comparative Analysis

Portfolio of electricity distributors with

- varying characteristics
- significant quantities of performance data
 - Financial
 - Volumetric
 - Service Quality
- Purpose is to adopt analytical tools that can help illuminate, improve understanding, draw intelligence regarding the portfolio so as to provide better regulation



Background

- Two stage Board staff consultation, start Nov '06
 - Invited comments on various matters
 - Provided data 2002-2005
- Report of Pacific Economics Group, April 2007
- Comments on PEG Report, July 4, 2007
- Technical Consultation Sept 12-13, 2007
 - Address capital (age and size)
 - Address service quality
- Staff provided PEG
 - 2006 data
 - Capital spending and customer growth data
 - Service quality data

Topics of Interest to Parties

- Data Improvement
 - Which improvements necessary (benefit > cost)
 - Any other issues
 - Phasing of the work short, medium, long term
- Methodologies
 - Use one method or combination
 - Which methods most appropriate and why
- Uses in Ratemaking
 - Screening, informing interrogatories, developing filing guidelines for rebasing
 - Establishing costs for setting revenue requirement
 - Other alternatives for setting X-Factor
 - Staged approach to use in incentive ratemaking

Preliminary Results, Latest Round

- Data relatively stable with 5th year (2006)
- Capital correlates with OM&A somewhat
- Service quality outage data not correlated with cost (perhaps measure not reliable)
- Service quality customer data not correlated with OM&A
- Degree of undergrounding significant

- Board staff complete analysis of 2006 mindful of participant comments
- Staff recommendation to Board on uses of comparative analysis early November
 - Rebasing
 - Incentive regulation
 - Next steps
- Board action as appropriate
