

# Integrated Power System Plan and Procurement Processes

Suggestions for Oral Submissions on Issues

#### Clear and specific requests

- Board has to write issues decision
- All benefit if that decision is clear
- How to help the Board do that while maximizing benefit to your client and the public interest
- Index: Suggested organization for a submission
- Don't have to speak to all, just the ones you care about

#### Basic structure of list

- What should issues list look like?
- What specific wording are you requesting?
  - OPA list good
  - OPA list OK, please add these issues
  - OPA list OK, please clarify that these topics are included in the list
  - OPA list no good: prefer GEC list, PWU list
  - OPA list no good: here's my list

#### Board's Role and Jurisdiction

- If you choose to address this topic, indicate what this means in a practical sense
  - E.g. effect on issues list?
  - Statement to guide parties?
    - Sample wording
- If you are asking the Board to include an issue, be clear about where the Board gets the jurisdiction and mandate to hear that issue

#### Implementation Barriers

- Should the Board consider as an issue potential barriers to plan implementation?
- If yes what specific barriers can be identified for consideration as issues to be addressed?
- Should the Board consider mechanisms to reduce such barriers?

## Implementation Barriers

- Review of Cost Responsibility Policies for Connection to Electricity Transmission Systems
- Board is examining this issue in a separate process, including "enabler lines"
- Given this other process, what remains to be done in IPSP?

## Scenario testing

- Is testing the methodology and accuracy of forecasts part of Plan review?
- Plan does contemplate scenario testing
- Should focus be on flexibility of Plan?
  - Forecasts may be wrong
  - Better to evaluate ability of Plan to accommodate changes in circumstances?

## Effect on Nations, Peoples and Regions

- Raised by a number of parties, some with proposals to address specific circumstances
- Be clear what issues and proposals you are asking the Board to include as an issue in the IPSP review
- Where is the Board's jurisdiction to grant your request?
- If not in IPSP, what are you asking the Board to do?

## Consultation

- Will you be raising any issues regarding consultation for the IPSP or procurement processes?
- If yes, please indicate this in your issues submission
- Differentiate between consultation for the IPSP, and consultation for the <u>projects</u> mentioned in the IPSP

#### **Procurement**

- Sufficient detail
  - Does issue need to be expanded?
  - Specify level of detail needed in list
  - Should potential mechanisms be listed?
- Is timing of procurement part of approval of procurement processes (barrier to implementation)?
