As part of Phase 1 of the IPSP proceeding, the Ontario Power Authority ("OPA") was instructed by the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") to develop a proposed issues list. Ontario Power Generation ("OPG") is pleased to comment on the issues list proposed by the OPA.
