ROS effective date earlier than TOS. When there is a pending enroll, upon the effective date of a TOS, each party is responsible for terminating the pending transactions in their own respective systems. New reason for SATTR – customer initiated drop. If there is a pending enroll and a pending drop for one month later, if vendor cancels enroll, the drop will be internally cancelled by each party.
