Applications were filed with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") pursuant to subsection 74(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B), by nine distributors for amendments to their licensed service areas. These applicants and the Board's assigned file numbers are listed below:

The Board decided to combine these applications into one proceeding as they raised similar issues of policy. The first phase of the proceeding focused on the general principles that should govern service area amendments. The Board has completed the hearing of evidence and submissions related to the general principles that should govern service area amendments, and issued its Decision on the principles on February 27, 2004.

The Board has now received correspondence from Essex Powerlines Corporation withdrawing its EB-2002-0524 application.

The Board has received correspondence from Centre Wellington Hydro Ltd. proposing an amendment to its application and requesting a final order of the Board on the application. This procedural order provides for the completion of the EB-1999-0269 application by Centre Wellington Hydro.

In its original application, filed July 8, 2002, Centre Wellington Hydro sought an amendment to its Distribution Licence ED-1999-0269 to include an expanded service area around the communities of Elora and Fergus. Hydro One opposed the application.

By letter dated July 21, 2004, Centre Wellington revised its application to seek an order of the Board to amend Schedule 1 of its distribution licence to include only specific lands associated with a new Upper Grand District High School located at 950 Scotland Street. These lands are described as Plan 61R9227, Part of Lot 14, Concession 2, of the former Township of Nichol, now within the Township of Centre Wellington and are within Hydro One's licensed service area. A copy of Centre Wellington's letter is appended to this procedural order.

The letter dated July 21, 2004 also indicated that Hydro One now supports the revised application, and consents to the proposed amendment of Centre Wellington's licence.

Any party who wishes to make final written submissions with regard to the amended application of Centre Wellington Hydro may file those submissions in accordance with this order. The Board reminds parties that the submissions should be specific to the circumstances of the Centre Wellington Hydro application.

- 1 Parties who wish to make final written submissions with regard to the amended application of Centre Wellington Hydro must file those submissions with the Board and copy them to all parties by August 19, 2004.

2 If the applicant, Centre Wellington Hydro, wishes to respond to any submissions received, it must file those responses with the Board and copy them to all parties by August 26, 2004.

3 All filings to the Board **must be in the form of one electronic copy, in WordPerfect or Word format, and pdf format if possible, as well as 5 hard copies**, to be received by the Board by 4:45 p.m. on the stated dates. Each party must send its submissions to all other parties as well as to the Board.
