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Interrogatory

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At page 2 of its evidence, Hydro One sets out four principles.

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- a) With respect to the first principle:
- 8 What time frame is meant by "longer term" in this principle?
- Would the minimization of short term costs prevent the achievement of this goal?

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- b) With respect to the second principle:
- Does "entire customer base" refer to customers over the entire province, or the customers of one utility?

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- c) With respect to the fourth principle:
- What length of time is contemplated in the "planning horizon" referred to?

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Response

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(a) The "longer term" time frame for planning is approximately 10 years. Focusing on the short-term only could lead to either redundant or unnecessary costs as a result of insufficient planning to implement the most cost-effective solution for a particular situation.

(b) The reference to the entire customer base is meant to refer to all customers in Ontario.

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(c) Networks' distribution planning horizon is considered to be 10 years.
