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## Ontario Energy Board (Board Staff) INTERROGATORY #8 (KEMA Report)

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## **Interrogatory**

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Is the utility planning process set out on pages 5 and 6 established in any regulatory document or requirement for Ontario distribution companies? If yes please provide the reference. Is the process typical of a wires-only electric distribution business?

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## **Response**

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The utility planning process for gas distribution utility system expansion is set out in the OEB's EBO 188 *Final Report of the Board*, dated January 30, 1998. The Board's findings at page 17 accept the utilities' 10 year forecast horizon for customer connections and planning horizons up to 40 years on page 10.

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Although the OEB has not reviewed electricity utility forecasting and planning processes as they did for gas utilities, the planning obligations for electricity distributors are set out in sections 3.2.3 and 3.4.1 of the Distribution System Code. The forecast and planning horizons set out in the EBO 188 Report are also prevalent in the electricity industry in Ontario and other jurisdictions, as described in the KEMA-Quantec Report.
