Interrogatory

At page 3 of the evidence, it is stated that if the Board chooses to allow overlapping service areas, "LDCs and their customers should not be disadvantaged as a result". Is this possible to achieve, in Network's opinion?

Response

No, in Networks' view the overall public interest is best served by maintaining defined service territories that do not overlap. If the Board decides to proceed with overlapping service territories, then the Board should set principles for compensation to be paid to incumbent LDCs so that they and their customers are held harmless, insofar as it is possible.
