6                    on proximity of a building to Hydro One's distribution system and a written request from  
7                    the owner, occupant or other person in charge of the building.

10                    to operate as an unlicensed distributor as permitted by section 4.0.1(1) of Regulation  
11                    161/99?

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13                    (d) Would Hydro One's position change if the unlicensed distributor wished to transfer  
14                    ownership and/or operation of its distribution system to a third party licensed embedded  
15                    distributor?
