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Wirebury Connections Inc. INTERROGATORY #9 (c, d, e) (Hydro One IR)

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Interrogatory

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As described in section 28 of the Electricity Act, the obligation to connect is contingent on proximity of a building to Hydro One's distribution system and a written request from the owner, occupant or other person in charge of the building.

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(c) Would Hydro One's position change if the customer requesting the connection wanted to operate as an unlicensed distributor as permitted by section 4.0.1(1) of Regulation 161/99?

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(d) Would Hydro One's position change if the unlicensed distributor wished to transfer ownership and/or operation of its distribution system to a third party licensed embedded distributor?

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(e) If the answer to (c) or (d) is yes, please fully explain Hydro One's position.
