

- Provincial targets assume that installed meters (800,000 in 2007) will be able to be used for billing TOU rates established by the OEB
- TOU rates set by the OEB may have 2-3 TOU periods, critical peak pricing and may have separate rates for customers with a smart meter vs. those that do not have one installed yet.
- A TOU rate for smart meters will be established and approved by May 2005
- Existing installations will be grandfathered until the life of the asset – grandfathered installations will count toward provincial targets
- Metering unmetered loads is not a requirement of this project but LDCs are not precluded from installing meters on loads that are currently unmetered if prudent to do so.
- Certain existing customer accounts will be allowed to be exempt from a smart meter installation
