To: All Electricity Local Distribution Companies (LDCs)

Re: Reporting Requirement for Conservation and Demand Management (CDM)-Electricity Distributors (RP-2004-0203)

The Board has communicated to LDCs that there will be a requirement for LDCs to report on their approved CDM plan quarterly and annually. The first quarterly filing for the period from January 1, 2005 to March 31, 2005 is due April 30, 2005.

This letter is to notify LDCs that the Board has released the Conservation and Demand Management Reporting web-based tool to assist LDCs in submitting their quarterly filings. The steps in accessing this tool are:

- From the OEB home page, click on the Utility Filing System (UFS) to view all Reporting tools for Distributors. Link into the Conservation Demand Management (CDM) Quarterly Filing section (shown under Web Page column).
- Read the instructions for the new web-based reporting system.
- Follow the link to open the CDM Quarterly Filing tool and enter data into the forms.

LDCs are required to report quarterly each program's status, rate class, planned objectives, and operating and capital expenditures. The Benefits to Date section is required only to be reported annually. A reconciliation to show the continuity of account 1565 is required as part of this quarterly filing. A text box has also been included to describe changes to CDM programs and the reasons for the changes.
