IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B of the *Energy Competition Act, 1998*:

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Terrace Bay Superior Wires Inc. for 2007 electricity distribution rates, effective May 1, 2007, in accordance with the 2nd Generation Incentive Regulation Mechanism issued December 20, 2006 by the Ontario Energy Board.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Terrace Bay Superior Wires Inc. (the "Company") is a licensed electricity distribution business operating in the Town of Terrace Bay under Licence # ED-2002-0543 with no special conditions in its' licence.
- 1.2 The Company submits this Application which includes the 2007 Incentive Regulation Mechanism (IRM) Model and the required documentation for the calculation of just and reasonable distribution rates effective May 1, 2007 in accordance with the Filing Guidelines issued by the Ontario Energy Board ("Board") and dated December 20, 2006.
- 1.3 The Company will prorate customer consumptions with pre-May 1, 2007 consumptions at the old rates, and post-May 1, 2007 consumption at the new rates.

2. Incentive Regulation Mechanism (IRM) Model

The following information summarizes the output of the IRM Model. Only sheets with information inputs are identified.

2.1 Sheet 1 *LDC Information*

As per the instructions issued by the Board, general information related to the application has been entered.

2.2 Sheet 2 2006 Rate Classes

As per the instructions issued by the Board, the classes as indicated on the Board-Approved 2006 Tariff of rates and charges have been entered.

2.3 Sheet 3 2006 Tariff Sheet

Terrace Bay Superior Wires Inc. has identified the approved rates and charges and the complete description of service classifications as found in the Board-Approved 2006 Tariff of rates and charges.

2.4 Sheet 4 2006 Smart Meter Information

The smart meter rate adder of \$0.27 for the various rate classes has been entered. This was taken from the Board-Approved 2006 EDR Model sheet 8-5. As an "Inactive Distributor" Terrace Bay Superior Wires Inc. is filing for a continuation of the smart meter adder that reflects \$0.30 per residential customer per month for 2007.

2.5 Sheet 6 CDM Adjustment

Terrace Bay Superior Wires Inc. has not applied for an incremental Conservation Demand Management adjustment, over and above the 3rd tranche in 2006.

2.6 Sheet 7 *LCT Adjustment*

Terrace Bay Superior Wires Inc. does not have Board approval for a Large Corporation Tax Allowance in 2006.

2.7 <u>Sheet 13</u> <u>Bill Impact - Annualised</u>

The following was taken from Sheet 13. "Bill Impact – Annualized" before GST (taxes).
