We are counsel to the Consumers Council of Canada. Our client has instructed us to advise the Board of its intention to participate in the 2006 EDR process.

Because of conflicting obligations, no representative of the CCC was able to attend the Pre-Consultation meeting held at .the Ontario Science Centre last week We understand that the Board has asked for submissions on preliminary issues, to be delivered by July 16,2004. The CCC will make every effort to deliver submissions on preliminary issues by that date. However, because of conflicting obligations to the completion of the pending Enbridge Gas Distribution Rates case, it may be impossible to do so.

The issue of whether, or to what extent, funding will be made available to allow participation by groups like the CCC in the 2006 EDR process has not been resolved. It is essential that that issue be resolved so that the CCC can determine the nature and extent of its participation in the process.
