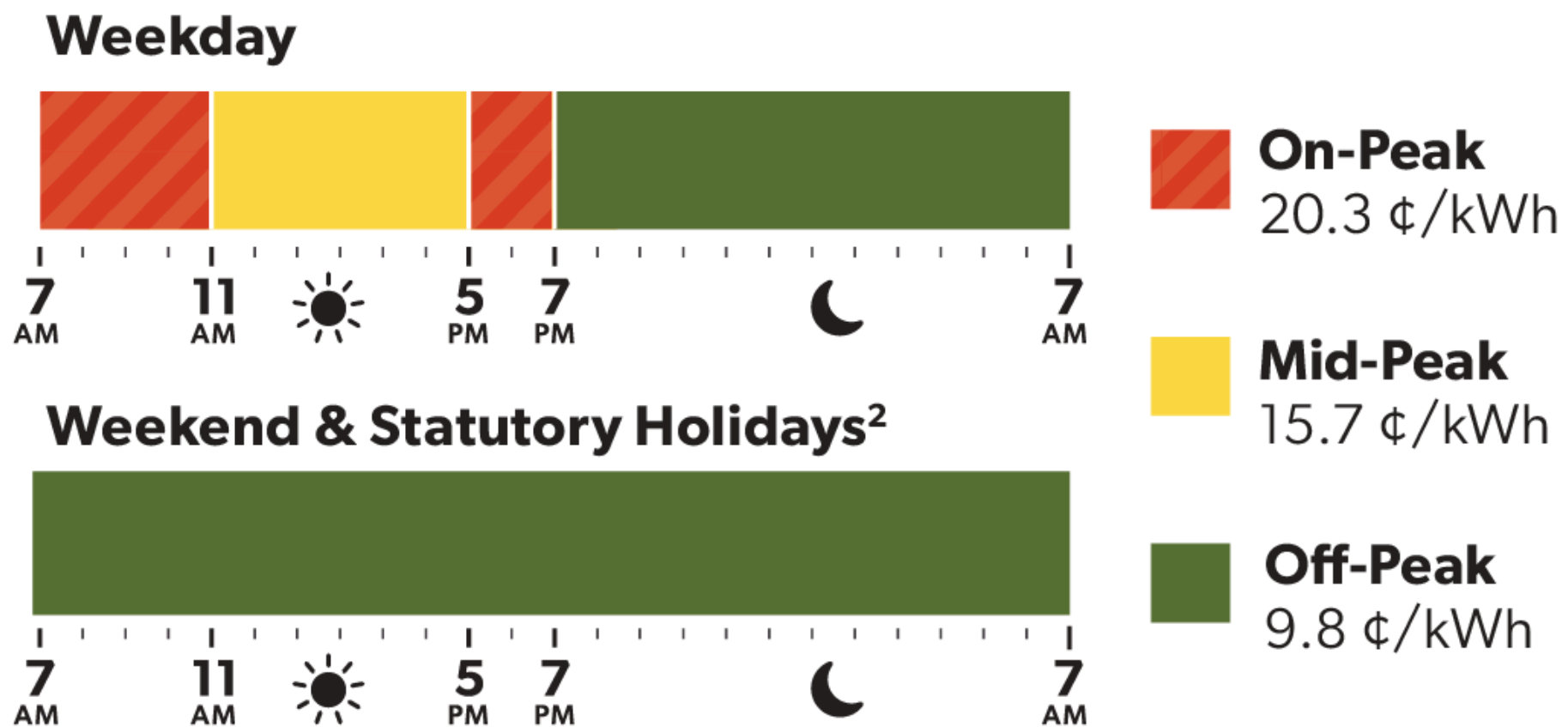

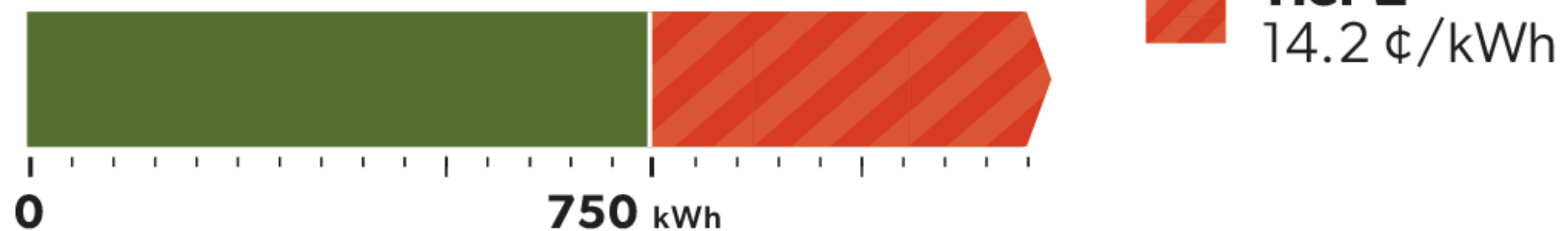
# Tiered Price Plan (kilowatt hours)

### Residential



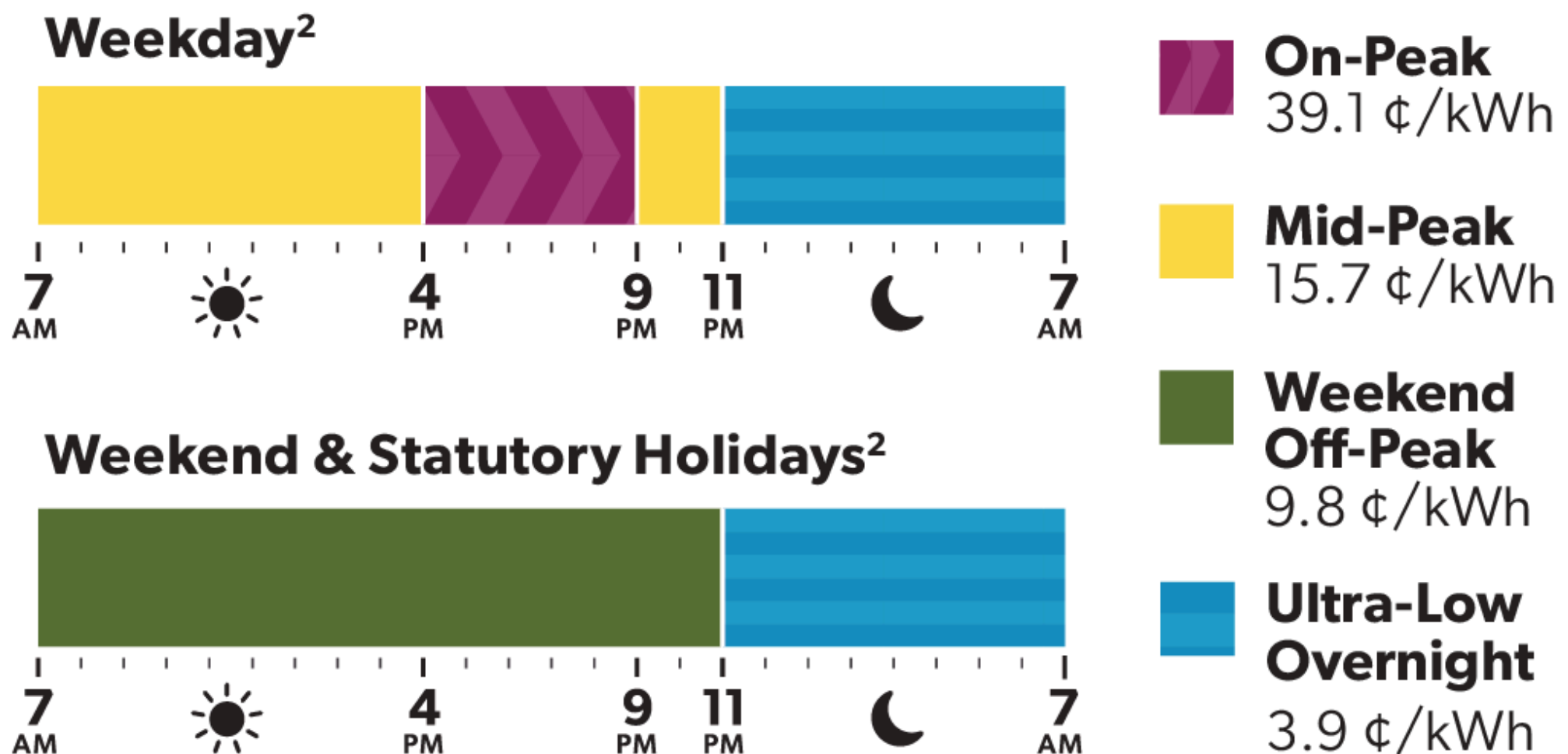
