IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*;

AND IN THE MATTER OF a proceeding on the Ontario Energy Board's own motion to amend electricity distributor, transmitter, retailer, wholesaler and generator licences, to implement reporting and record keeping requirements for electricity licensees.

DECISION AND ORDER

On August 16, 2002, the Board commenced a proceeding on its own motion under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, to amend electricity distributor, transmitter, retailer, wholesaler and generator licences. The Board finds that it is in the public interest to amend these licences to provide the Board and the Director of Licensing with broader authority to require information.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT the existing subsections of electricity licences referred to below be replaced with the following:

A Distribution Licence subsection 10.1

The Licensee shall maintain records of and provide, in the manner and form determined by the Board or the Director, such information as the Board or the Director may require from time to time.

B Transmission Licence subsection 10.1

The Licensee shall maintain records of and provide, in the manner and form determined by the Board or the Director, such information as the Board or the Director may require from time to time.

C Retailer Licence subsection 11.1

The Licensee shall maintain records of and provide, in the manner and form determined by the Board or the Director, such information as the Board or the Director may require from time to time.

D Wholesaler Licence subsection 10.1

The Licensee shall maintain records of and provide, in the manner and form determined by the Board or the Director, such information as the Board or the Director may require from time to time.

E Generation Licence subsection 10.1

The Licensee shall maintain records of and provide, in the manner and form determined by the Board or the Director, such information as the Board or the Director may require from time to time.
