RATE ORDER

North Bay Hydro Distribution Ltd. ("North Bay Hydro") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 26, 2009. The application was filed under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O 1998, c. 15 (Sched. B) seeking approval for changes to the rates that it charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2010.

The Board issued its Decision on the application on April 8, 2010. In the Decision, the Board ordered the Applicant to file a draft Rate Order reflecting the Board's findings in the Decision. The Board approved an implementation date and an effective date of May 1, 2010.

On March 17, 2010, the Board issued a rate order approving a province-wide fixed monthly charge for all electricity distributors related to the microFIT generator rate class at a rate of \$5.25 per month, effective September 21, 2009.

The Applicant filed a draft Rate Order and supporting material on April 12, 2010. The Board notes that in its draft Rate Order, North Bay Hydro complied with the March 17, 2010 microFIT order. Two intervenors filed comments on April 13, 2010. On April 14, 2010 the Applicant filed a revised Draft Rate Order.

The Board has reviewed the information provided in support of the revised draft Rate Order and the proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges. The Board is satisfied that the Tariff of Rates and Charges accurately reflects the Board's Decision.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix "A" of this Rate Order is approved effective May 1, 2010 for electricity consumed or estimated to have been consumed on and after such date.
- 2. The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix "A" of this Order supersedes all previous Tariff of Rates and Charges approved by the Ontario Energy Board for the North Bay Hydro Distribution Ltd. service area, and is final in all respects.
- 3. North Bay Hydro Distribution Ltd. shall notify its customers of the rate changes no later than with the first bill reflecting the new rates.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE CLASSIFICATION

This classification applies to an account taking electricity at 750 volts or less where the electricity is used exclusively in a separate metered living accommodation. Customers shall be residing in single-dwelling units that consist of a detached house or one unit of a semi-detached, duplex, triplex or quadruplex house, with a residential zoning. Separately metered dwellings within a town house complex or apartment building also qualify as residential customers. All customers are single-phase. Further servicing details are available in the distributor's Conditions of Service.

APPLICATION

The application of these rates and charges shall be in accordance with the Licence of the Distributor and any Code or Order of the Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Board, which may be applicable to the administration of this schedule.

No rates and charges for the distribution of electricity and charges to meet the costs of any work or service done or furnished for the purpose of the distribution of electricity shall be made except as permitted by this schedule, unless required by the Distributor's Licence or a Code or Order of the Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Board, or as specified herein.

Unless specifically noted, this schedule does not contain any charges for the electricity commodity, be it under the Regulated Price Plan, a contract with a retailer or the wholesale market price, as applicable.

It should be noted that this schedule does not list any charges or assessments that are required by law to be charged by a distributor and that are not subject to Board approval, such as the Debt Retirement Charge, charges for Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure Conservation and Renewable Energy Program, the Provincial Benefit and any applicable taxes.
