#### **REVISED RATE ORDER**

#### Introduction

Orillia Power Distribution Corporation ("Orillia Power"), a licensed distributor of electricity, filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 28, 2010, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Orillia Power charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2011.

On April 7, 2011, the Board issued its Decision and Order on the application. In its Decision, the Board ordered Orillia Power to review the draft Tariff of Rates and Charges and to file with the Board written confirmation assessing the completeness and accuracy of the draft Tariff of Rates and Charges, or provide a detailed explanation of any inaccuracies or missing information, within seven calendar days of the date of the Decision.

On April 14, 2011, Orillia Power filed a letter noting the following wording issues in the draft Tariff of Rates and Charges:

- Orillia requested that the reference to Low Voltage Volumetric Rate for all classifications be changed to Low Voltage Service Rate. Orillia Power also noted that the word "Voltage" is missing under the Street Lighting service classification.
- Orillia Power noted that the word "average" is missing from the description for the Unmetered Scattered Load service classification.
- Orillia Power noted that the reference to "Provincial Benefit", in the last paragraph under the "Application" heading, for all service classifications, should be revised to "Global Adjustment" to be consistent with Ontario Regulation 398/10 Section 16(7), which amended Ontario Regulation 429/04 effective January 1, 2011.

The Board accepts Orillia Power's submission and has revised the Tariff of Rates and Charges.

#### THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

 The revised Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix A of this order will become final effective May 1, 2011, and will apply to electricity consumed or estimated to have been consumed on and after May 1, 2011. Orillia Power shall notify its customers of the rate changes no later than with the first bill reflecting the new rates.

Customers shall be residing in single-dwelling units that consist of a detached house or one unit of a semi-detached, duplex, triplex or quadruplex house, with a residential zoning, Separately metered dwellings within a town house complex or apartment building also qualify as residential customers. Further servicing details are available in the distributor's Conditions of Service.

#### **APPLICATION**

The application of these rates and charges shall be in accordance with the Licence of the Distributor and any Code or Order of the Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Board, which may be applicable to the administration of this schedule.

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Unless specifically noted, this schedule does not contain any charges for the electricity commodity, be it under the Regulated Price Plan, a contract with a retailer or the wholesale market price, as applicable.

It should be noted that this schedule does not list any charges, assessments or credits that are required by law to be invoiced by a distributor and that are not subject to Board approval, such as the Debt Retirement Charge, charges for Ministry of Energy Conservation and Renewable Energy Program, the Global Adjustment, the Ontario Clean Energy Benefit and the HST.
