In response to the Ontario Energy Board's request on April 20, 2007 the Ontario Power Authority (the "OPA") is hereby filing its second phase of a three year plan to address the possible overloading at the Armitage Transformer Station. The OPA filed the first phase of the plan on May 31, 2007 to address the short-term electricity requirements in Northern York Region for the summer of 2007.

The information and results the OPA has received on the loading of the Armitage Transformer Station this past summer has informed its second phase plan covering the period from October 2007 to the end of 2009, and specifically, a remedial action plan for the summer periods (June to September) in both 2008 and 2009.

This report incorporates the views of the IESO, Hydro One and the York Region Distributors. The OPA wishes to again thank these parties for their co-operation and assistance in completing this document.
