## **Setting the context**

- Board staff gave a presentation outlining the history of LEAP and provided an overview of current OEB low-income initiatives.
- Outlined mandate/objective of FAWG.
- Discussed what has changed since 2009 consultation and the following factors were identified:
  - Low-income customer service rules.
  - o Northern Ontario Energy Credit and Ontario Energy and Property Tax Credit.

- Emergency Energy Fund
- o HST.

#### **Low Income Statistics**

 Board staff presented an analysis of low-income statistics based on 2006 census data.

## **Electricity Late Payment Settlement**

- Steve Lavery of the United Way Toronto outlined the terms and current status of the settlement.
- Working group discussed possibility of using a similar administrative model for LEAP and any impact these additional funds will have.

### **Role of Suite Meter Providers**

- Allen Maclure of Enbridge Electric Connections Inc. provided an overview of the roles of suite meter providers as well as a description of some of the different business models used by the companies.
- Differences between standard LDC residential customers and SSM provider customers and how they pertain to LEAP funding were discussed.

## **OPA Low-Income CDM Program**

- Katherine Sparkes of the OPA provided a brief description of the OPA's lowincome CDM initiative.
- Working group discussed ways of linking OPA low-income CDM programs to LEAP to maximize benefits to low-income customers.

### Review of FAWG's 2009 recommendations

- Board staff provided a review of the prior recommendations of the FAWG.
- Discussed desire to continue with original proposal of using LICO table to determine LEAP eligibility.
- FAWG agreed to continue to use the complete LICO table (incorporating household size and community size).
  - Agreed to use a 15% adder to LICO table cutoffs for LEAP eligibility, with a review after one year.

### **Action Items:**

- OEB staff to confirm definition of low-income households used by Statistics Canada.
- OEB staff to determine if low-income statistics can be shared for all LDCs. If so,
   OEB staff will prepare a table with all LDCs for next FAWG meeting.
