Framework elements

- Eligibility
 - under discussion
- Intake and application
 - Lead/Intake model
 - RFP for Lead agency
 - Lead agency maintains lists of participating (intake) agencies, by area, for LDCs and OEB
 - Automate information exchange between Intake and LDC
 - Proposed Code amendments say 21 days disconnection notice, “additional time to make arrangements to pay arrears”
- Promotion and outreach
 - Targeted during first year of program, to track and monitor demand and response capability



Framework elements

- Tracking and reporting
 - Per Winter Warmth established reporting
 - Add “reason for grant provided”
- Funding
 - Per Winter Warmth processes
- Long-term coordination
 - Establish Steering committee to evaluate program at 6 and 12 months; recommend modifications.
