CDM Program and Strategies (EB-2010-0215/EB-2010-0216)

We are counsel to Attawapiskat Power Corporation (**APC**), Fort Albany Power Corporation (**FAPC**) and Kashechewan Power Corporation (**KPC**). As discussed in previous correspondence with the Board, APC, FAPC and KPC have worked diligently with the Ontario Power Authority (**OPA**) to develop a modified form of the standard CDM programs offered by other distributors via the Master CDM Program Agreement (**Master Agreement**). The amended Master Agreements, which were made effective on June 18, 2013, are designed to account for the community-specific needs of Attawapiskat, Fort Albany and Kashechewan.

As per the Board's request, we are now providing an update on the proposed CDM Program funding for each LDC. Originally, each of the above-mentioned LDCs was to receive approximately \$240,000.00 in Program Administration Budget Funding (**PAB Funding**). Due to the unique geographic, social, and economic circumstances in their service areas, however, some of the OPA-Contracted Province-Wide CDM Programs are untenable for these LDCs. (As an example, because there is no industry in these communities, they have not registered to deliver the Industrial Program.) These issues are explained in the CDM Strategies filed on June 6, 2013.

As a result, the OPA and LDCs have negotiated the following revised PAB Funding amounts with each LDC under their respective Master Agreements:

- APC PAB Funding (basic + "enhanced" funding) = approximately \$569,943.00
- FAPC PAB (basic + "enhanced" funding) = approximately \$511,032.10
- KPC PAB (basic + "enhanced" funding) = approximately \$576,396.00
