
Re: Implementation of Consumer Protection (Retailer/Marketer) Provisions of the *Energy Consumer Protection Act, 2010* (EB-2010-0245)

On October 6, 2010 the Working Groups reported back to the Board on the progress of discussions relating to potential EBT implications associated with the implementation of the consumer protection provisions of the *Energy Consumer Protection Act, 2010* (the "ECPA").


On October 21, 2010, the Board acknowledged receipt of that letter, and itemized developments that have subsequently occurred, including the filing of final regulations made under the ECPA and the revised proposed amendments to its regulatory instruments regarding implementation of the ECPA issued by the Board. The Board requested that the Working Groups confirm whether any additional issues related to the current EBT processes arise in relation to the implementation of the ECPA, in particular in respect of areas where the final regulation differ from the draft versions and areas where the Board's revised proposed amendments differ from the amendments as originally proposed. The Working Groups were asked to report back to the Board by November 4, 2010.

The Board's letter was forwarded by email to the distribution lists of each of the Working Groups, together with an offer to arrange a meeting at the request of any member of the Working Groups to discuss any identified issues. The members of the Working Groups have not identified any potential issues related to the current EBT processes that arise from the legislation or revised proposed amended regulatory instruments.
