# Cyber-security Questionnaire

- Working group met on November 20
- Draft questionnaire for distribution company executives based on [“Cybersecurity Questions for CEOs”](#) document published by US Department of Homeland Security has been developed for the Advisory Committee’s consideration.
- Based on comments received today, questionnaire will be finalized at next working group meeting (January 23)
- Depending on today’s feedback from the Committee, expect to send out questionnaire in February (Board staff will send on behalf of the Committee).

# Real-time Data Access Recommendations

- Met on October 17, November 14, and January 14.
- Working Group currently finalizing draft observations and recommendations on data access for low volume customers
- Near-final draft provided for discussion today
- Advisory Committee to discuss next steps

# Working Group Update: Storage

- Met on October 17, November 12 & 26, and January 16
- Working Group developing a document identifying barriers to storage, solution options, options to achieve solutions
- LTEP states that “government also intends to initiate work, priority basis, to address regulatory barriers that limit the ability of energy storage companies to compete in Ontario’s electricity market.” (p. 83)
- Minister of Energy directed the OPA and IESO to jointly report back to the Minister with a proposed design and outline for an energy storage procurement framework by January 31, 2014. The proposed procurement framework will include IESO-led procurements and OPA-led procurements.
- SGAC’s Storage Working Group invited to provide input at meeting on January 17
- Currently, still expect to finalize working group’s recommendations to SGAC in Q1 2014
