1. Teleconference to check on operation of EBT after first week of production	<p>GENERAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No major problems or issues were reported. Systems still undergoing some fine tuning and balancing. <p>SPECIFIC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Direct Energy reported that they had received large synchronization files – CCI's – from Union last night, but received less than half of those expected from Enbridge. Enbridge confirmed files have been sent (70 active/1 in-flight), but that FAs have not been received. Both DE and Enbridge will review to see if there are any problems that cannot be resolved. Direct Energy reported that they are not seeing the volumes they had expected, e.g. for Union, TOS transactions; for Enbridge, IRR transactions. Union reported that approximately 2000 TOS transactions had been sent – they will let DE know if document responses are not received. Enbridge reported that a transition was required from May to June, and that an item on a data patch for the May records would be emailed and put on the portal this morning. Enbridge noted that user access to ENTRAC gives access to the portal – they are on a common platform. Superior received a response to a question regarding SA-NPS.
