Re: Revision to Guideline G-2008-0001 - Electricity Distribution Retail
Transmission Service Rates

Attached is revision 3.0 of the Guideline G-2008-0001 - Electricity Distribution Retail Transmission Service Rates (the "Guideline"). This Guideline outlines the information that the Board requires electricity distributors to file to adjust their retail transmission service rates ("RTSRs") for 2012. The revisions to the Guideline will require electricity distributors to adjust their RTSRs based on a comparison of historical transmission costs adjusted for the new Ontario Uniform Transmission Rates ("UTRs") levels and revenues generated under existing RTSRs. In order to assist electricity distributors in the calculation of the distributor's specific RTSRs, Board staff has posted a RTSR filing module on the Board's website. Although a model has been provided, the onus remains on the distributor to ensure the accuracy of the RTSRs for which approval is being sought.

The methodology to calculate the new RTSRs will apply to both incentive regulation mechanism ("IRM") and cost of service rate applications for 2012.

The Guideline also includes the UTRs approved by the Board effective January 1, 2011.

Once January 1, 2012 UTR adjustments are determined, the Board will adjust each distributor's 2012 IRM rate application model to incorporate this change, if applicable. In the event that new Uniform Transmission Rates are approved during the course of a cost-of-service proceeding, the distributor should update the UTRs in their evidence to reflect the new rates by the distributor.
