Re: Handbook to Electricity Distributor and Transmitter Consolidations and Filing Requirements For Consolidation Applications

Today the OEB has posted on its <u>website</u>, a Handbook to provide guidance to applicants and stakeholders on applications to the OEB for approval of electricity distributor and transmitter consolidations. The Handbook also discusses the ratemaking policies associated with consolidations and sets out the timing of when such

matters will be considered by the OEB.

The OEB is committed to reducing regulatory barriers to consolidation. In order to facilitate both a thorough and timely review of requests for approval of transactions, in this Handbook the OEB provides guidance on the process for review of an application, the information the OEB expects to receive in support, and the approach it will take in assessing the merits of the consolidation in meeting the public interest.

To assist applicants, the OEB has developed Filing Requirements included as Appendices to this Handbook which set out the information that needs to be provided in an application.
