Re: Utility Remuneration (EB-2018-0287) and Responding to Distributed Energy Resources (EB-2018-0288) Written Comment Phase Following September Stakeholder Meeting

On September 17 – 19, 2019, the OEB held a stakeholder meeting to receive input on the objectives, issues and guiding principles for Utility Remuneration and Responding to Distributed Energy Resources (DERs). The July invitation letter indicated following the meeting staff would prepare a report describing the input received and setting out a proposal outlining objectives, issues and guiding principles for each initiative.

Over the three meeting days, stakeholders made presentations and discussed potential approaches to responding to sector evolution. Toward the conclusion of the meeting, some stakeholders requested the opportunity to provide written comments prior to OEB staff's report. They noted the benefits of being able to synthesize their views given the breadth of the issues and diversity of views expressed, as well as the opportunity to express any refinements or changes to their views that may have arisen over the course of the meeting.

In light of this feedback, the OEB has elected to make provision for written comments from stakeholders that summarize their views on what the objectives, specific problems or issues to be addressed and guiding principles should be for each of these initiatives.

All interested stakeholders are welcome to submit written comments by October 18, 2019. Filing instructions are included in Attachment A.

The OEB has also determined that costs will be available to those participants that have been determined by the OEB to be eligible, as follows:
