Re: Continuation of Temporary Monthly Reporting Requirement Related to the Impact on Distributors Arising from the COVID-19 Emergency

On October 05, 2020, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) extended the temporary monthly reporting requirements related to the impact arising from the COVID-19 emergency for electricity distributors, electricity transmitters, and Ontario Power Generation until the end of January 2021 reflecting information to December 31, 2020. The extension recognized the ongoing nature of both the COVID-19 pandemic and the EB-2020-0133 consultation regarding the COVID-19 deferral accounts.

Given the ongoing COVID-19 emergency and the EB-2020-0133 consultation, the OEB has determined that it is necessary to continue the temporary reporting requirement with the last report to be filed at the end of April 2021 for the March reporting period.

Both the <u>distributor excel worksheet</u> and <u>transmitter and OPG excel worksheet</u> have been updated to reflect this extension. They can be found on the OEB's website under <u>Reporting-and Record-keeping Requirements</u>.
