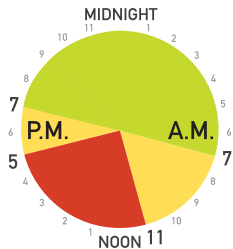


Managing costs with time-of-use prices

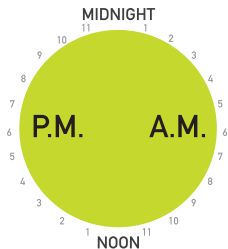


Ontario electricity time-of-use price periods:

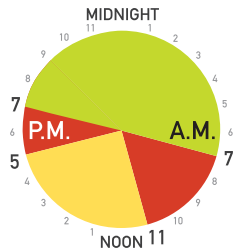


Summer
