


7 Things You Should Know About Energy Contracts

- Door-to-door energy retailers can't sign you up for an energy contract while they are at your home
- 2 There are limits on when energy retailers can come to your home to market or advertise their business
- 3 The time that you can cancel an energy contract without

- 4 You will be contacted 10-45 days after you've entered into the contract to verify that you wish to continue with it
- 5 Auto-renewal of all energy contracts is eliminated
- 6 Cancellation fees for most residential consumers are reduced

penalty is extended to 30 days after you receive your second bill under the energy contract Energy retailers are required to include OEB-approved plain language terms and conditions in their energy contracts
