



Help with your energy bills

Programs For Lower-income Energy Customers

LEAP

The Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP) provides emergency assistance of up to \$500 (\$600 for electrically heated homes) to eligible low-income customers. This assistance is available to those who are behind on their electricity or natural gas bills and face immediate service disconnection.

OESP

The Ontario Electricity Support Program (OESP) provides eligible low-income customers with a monthly on-bill credit to reduce their electricity bills. The amount of the credit varies, but for most customers it ranges from \$35 to \$75 per month.
