POSITION OVERVIEW

- Acts as the OEB's subject matter expert regarding distribution system planning and distributed energy resources.
- Conducts policy research including evaluating and analyzing policy options and their implications on the sector.
- Prepare documents to solicit stakeholder feedback.
- Develops policy options by leading stakeholder consultations and directing projects and project teams.
- Monitors the energy and regulatory policy environment to identify changes in the industry, trends and emerging issues; building relationships with stakeholders, commissions and industry associations
- Reviews and revises regulatory policies and processes to adapt to changes in the industry.
- Develops an understanding of the regulations and codes of the electricity sector.

 Develops an understanding of various codes and regulations, such as the Distribution System Code (DSC), the Transmission System Code (TSC), the Affiliate Relations Code (ARC), and the Retail Settlement Code (RSC) that relate to the sector, in order to provide guidance to stakeholders and internal staff. Provides guidance in relation to an extensive understanding of related OEB decisions.
