- Reviews all regulatory accounting, financial, and tax matters and provides expert advice as an individual or team member
- Acts as subject matter expert relating to accounting related matters in rates, leaves to construct, Mergers, Acquisitions, Amalgamations and Divestitures (MAADs) and other cases
- Leads or participates in the settlement of issues with applicants and other stakeholders develops interrogatories, participates in technical conference questioning, prepares briefing notes, staff submissions and cross-examinations in preparation of public hearings
- Leads or participates in the OEB's policy related initiatives and studies
- Maintains and develops regulatory accounting/tax section of the rate application filing guidelines, accounting procedures handbook, and the uniform system of accounts of regulated utilities
